Animal crossing pocket camp latest version

Animal Crossing: Pocket Camp, the smartphone entry in the long-running Nintendo series, has been updated with a pair of new augmented reality features. The first, AR camera, allows you to place characters and furniture from the game in the real world and photograph them. Meanwhile, the AR Cabin feature allows players to decorate a virtual cabin, fill it with characters, and then display it in augmented reality from their smartphone. Along with the new AR modes, Nintendo says the update means that several areas of each campsite can have furniture and items placed in them. AR Cabin allows you to assemble a virtual space and then explore it in augmented reality. Picture: Nintendo Unfortunately, the new features have increased the game's system requirements, and earlier versions of the game are now useless after the update. A support post notes that iPhone users now require iOS version 11 at least (or ideally iOS 13 and above) instead of iOS 9, which was the previous requirement. Android users must now be running Android 5 or later on a 64-bit device with at least 1.5 GB of RAM. That's up from the previous requirement for Android version 4.4 and 1.5GB of RAM. According to the same support document, Animal Crossing: Pocket Camp cannot be downloaded or played on devices that are no longer supported. The change has infuriated some players. The responses to the official Pocket Camp Twitter account are littered with complaints from players who no longer have access to the game after the update. A specific issue appears to be the requirement for a 64-bit Android device, with some players reporting that they cannot run the game on 64-bit hardware because of a 32-bit operating system. Picture: Nintendo In certain cases, some devices may not be supported even when they meet the conditions listed, a support post about the update from last month read. Nintendo says storage data can be transferred to a new device if players have already connected their Nintendo accounts to their game. When setting up a new device, you must select the Link Nintendo Account option when you start the game for the first time, which allows you to import existing storage data. Please note that Leaf Tickets, a real moneyable in-game currency, cannot be transferred between Android and iOS devices. Coinciding with the update, Nintendo offers a free month of Furniture & Fashion Plan, which offers benefits such as expanded storage for items and the ability to get exclusive furniture and clothing. The subscription normally costs \$7.99 (£7.99/€8.99) a month. On the flip side, if you are one of those players who no longer have a device that can play the game, Nintendo recommends that you cancel any in-game subscriptions to prevent future costs.
